## **Academy Governing Board Role Profile**



#### **Role Overview**

As a Governor with The Thinking Schools Academy Trust, your role is to perform a 'non-executive' strategic function, uphold the values of the school & Trust and ensure the school deliver a good quality of education to all our students. You will be supporting and holding to account the leaders who are responsible for the operational and strategic running of the school. You will be talking about how the school is performing, as well as thinking about the future and how they can improve, to offer the best possible education and experience to its students to transform their life chances.

### **Commitment**

Academy Governing Boards will meet or engage with the school once per term, six times per year. In order to fulfil their responsibilities, Governors need to engage with the school in a variety of ways. These will include attendance at all meetings, school visits and (where available) contribution to panel hearings such as Governor Discipline Panels to review suspensions & exclusions.

#### **Specific Role Details**

Academy Governing Boards (AGBs) are a skills-based governing body, with people who have skills in areas such as Education, Human Resources and Safeguarding. AGBs have delegated responsibility to have oversight of the performance of Academies and work within their <u>Terms of Reference</u> which are outlined within the document.

You will have the opportunity to take on a link role that is aligned with your skills/experience/interests that will narrow your focus on the Governing Board to be an advocate for that area. Link role areas include:

## What support is available to Governors:

-School Clerk – Your Clerk is your first port of call for assistance/guidance.
